

Rosa Orenstein Discusses Possible GM Bankruptcy

According to recent media reports, the Treasury Department is supposedly directing General Motors to lay the groundwork for a bankruptcy filing by a June 1 deadline, despite G.M.'s public contention that it could still reorganize outside court.
