

Dallas Court of Appeals Affirms Gray Reed Jury Verdict for Jani-King International, Inc.

On July 11, the Fifth District Court of Appeals affirmed a \$350,000 <u>jury verdict</u> obtained by Gray Reed attorneys <u>Ken Stone</u> and <u>Jonathan Hyman</u> on behalf of Jani-King International, Inc. in a suit against its former New York franchisee.

The court <u>affirmed</u> the jury's findings that the franchisee breached both the royalty payment and non-compete provisions of the parties' franchise agreement and that the franchisee's counterclaims were meritless.
