She was touched that at the final hearing, Kathy brought a notebook she kept throughout the legal proceedings containing all of the emails Lamb had written to her. “She was so visibly relieved to have this behind her.”

Taylor, an associate in the firm’s corporate section, has worked on pro bono matters through Gray Reed since the firm founded its pro bono committee in 2012.
