

Compete Rule—16 C.F.R. § 910.1-.6—against Plaintiff Ryan, LLC, from the date of this order to the Court’s final adjudication on the merits. The Court hereby stays the effective date of the Rule as to Plaintiff Ryan, LLC.

2. The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) and its respective agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and all persons acting in concert with the FTC are wholly enjoined from implementation of or enforcement of the Non-Compete Rule—16 C.F.R. § 910.1-.6—against Plaintiff Intervenor: Chamber of Commerce of the United States of America; Business Roundtable; Texas Association of Business; and Longview Chamber of Commerce, from the date of this order to the Court’s final adjudication on the merits. The Court hereby stays the effective date of the Rule as to these Plaintiff-Intervenor.

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(c), the Court waives the requirement of a bond. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(c).
