LATINA VOICES: SMART TALK is an innovative, English language, half-hour television and internet streamed talk show with a Latina perspective but addressing universal topics such as politics, business, pop culture, health trends, entertainment, women's issues and newsworthy other topics of value to professional Latinos and the mainstream audience.

LATINA VOICES: SMART TALK will be hosted by show creator and Executive Producer MINERVA PÉREZ, an award-winning Broadcast Journalist and Community Leader; SOFIA ADROGUÉ, a Rice University and Harvard Business School Alumna and a "Texas Super Lawyer"; and PATRICIA GRAS, an Emmy-award winning Houston PBS Senior Host/Producer.

Media research holds that middle-class professional and educated Latinos who live in the United States are dismissed by mainstream Media. Yet, they hold the power of the purse worth 700 billion dollars. Countless national advocacy groups contend there needs to be more broadcast programming with the Hispanic American perspective. LATINA VOICES: SMART TALK will fill that void.

The 44 million Hispanics who live in the U.S. are a multi-lingual, multi-cultural segment of the population and growing. Projections show that the Latino population will grow to nearly 67 million by 2050, overtaking other minority groups as a majority. The National Hispanic Media Coalition based in Los Angeles, CA promotes Latino inclusion in television, radio, film and all other media making it perfect timing for this kind of programming.

LATINA VOICES: SMART TALK designed to empower Latinos in general will also appeal to a mainstream audience. Its target audience is the general market audience between the ages of 30 and 65, a group with the biggest buying power, interest and maturity to enjoy this type of programming.

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

**LATINA VOICES: SMART TALK** will air monthly on HTV, Comcast Cable 16 in Houston, and will be streamed on the internet on www.htvhouston.net and www.latinavoices.com. The program is in negotiation with Houston PBS for the possibility of distribution nationally.

LATINA VOICES: SMART TALK will begin with a discussion by the Co-Hostesses in a segment called "Let's Talk" covering politics, business, news, (local, national and international) health and lifestyle issues and current affairs.

A major feature of LATINA VOICES: SMART TALK is a NEWSMAKER segment that will feature a prominent guest or personality. Our first show featured Houston born Olympic Medalist Raj Bhavsar and his Olympic coach Kevin Mazeika.
